The Round Barn with the buggies, wagons and other antiques on display is the hub of the museum grounds. The walkway made of personal paver bricks is in place. Also this year will be a new addition, the Beaver Creek Tack Room. The James Building has been refurbished with wallpaper and rearranging. New displays are constantly being added.

The Fort Crook Cabin that has been furnished with historically correct furnishing will be the campsite of the Fort Crook Dragoon Soldiers where they will do some of their reenactments.

We are pleased to have the Dutch Oven Cook-off, Black Smithing, Pioneer Trades, Craft Fair, Food Booths, Fort Crook Soldiers, Old Time Engines, Logging Exhibit, Pit River Pioneers and music to entertain you through the day.
